Rules and Regulations

I.) INTRODUCTION:

College Scholarship Program

The APWU College Scholarship program is a self-perpetuating financial base for providing significant educational assistance to children of APWU union members. It awards \$250.00 for college to at least one recipient.

Vocational Scholarship Program:

The APWU established the Vocational Scholarship to help students interested in programs of study leading to trade, technical, industrial or vocational occupations that can include: Culinary, Medical or Dental Assistant, Electrician, Real Estate, Auto Mechanic, Certified I/T-Computer Education, Massage Therapy or Cosmetology. It awards \$250.00 for college to at least one recipient.

II.) ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicant must be a senior attending high school or other corresponding secondary school.

Applicant must be child or grandchild, including stepchild or legally adopted child of an active member, Retirees Department member, or deceased member of the American Postal Workers Union.

Applicant's parent or grandparent must be a full dues paying member or retirees member (as defined in the APWU National Constitution and Bylaws, reference Article 3, Section 1, Section 4(d) in good standing for at least one year immediately preceding application deadline or must have been a member for one year immediately preceding death. Applicants whose parent or grandparent is currently part of management are not eligible.

Scholarship recipient for this award must attend an accredited college or university. Recipients for the Vocational awards must attend an accredited community college, vocational school or vocational program.

Awards are for one year of study at the selected school.
